

# BSA Climbing Instructor Training

April 26-28 & May 3-5

## Become a BSA Climbing Instructor

Participants will enjoy two weekends of classroom and hands-on training, including instruction in climbing technique, safety considerations, gear selection and care, group instruction and route selection and set-up. These topics will be presented by experienced members of the council climbing committee.

The first weekend will focus on classroom sessions in Oregon City. The second weekend will be hands-on skills at Horsethief Butte.

Persons age 16 and 17 are able to attend with a paying adult, but only those 18 and up are eligible to receive a training card as a *BSA Climbing Instructor*. Upon successful completion of this course, individuals satisfactorily demonstrating their instructional, management and anchoring skills will receive a training card as a *BSA Climbing Instructor*.

**Course prerequisites:** MUST have prior climbing experience; this is not a beginner class. Must also be current in Youth Protection training, Weather Hazard training, Climb-On Safely training and have a current BSA Medical Form, Part A, B & C signed by a physician.
